DTA is a platform where the next generation of academics and researchers can understand the worth of collaborative projects through the sharing of knowledge, ideas and resources.



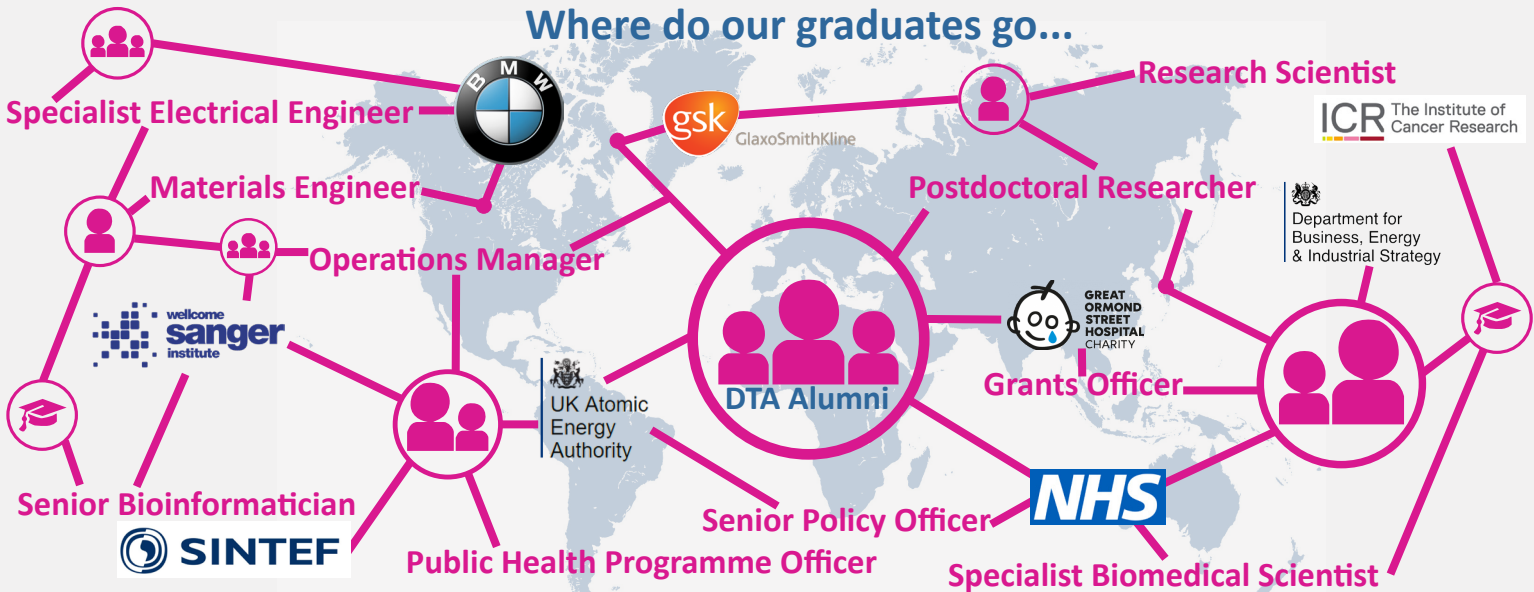
